Michele Rinaldi is an Italian philologist. Between 1999-2021 he was a member of several National Research Projects and organizer (as a voluntary assistant) of the VI Congress of the International Medieval Latin Committee (*Auctor et auctoritas in latinis medii aevi litteris*, Napoli-Benevento, 10-14 novembre 2010). He is a member of the board of teachers of the Doctorate in Texts, Traditions, and Book Cultures at the Scuola Superiore Meridionale (SSM); in addition, he is a member of the SFLI (Società dei Filologi della Letteratura Italiana), member of the scientific board of Centro Pio Rajna (Rome), partner of the Casa di Dante (Rome), Senior Researcher of the Illuminated Dante Project (IDP), and Research Associate of the PAL Project (Ptolemaeus arabus et latinus) hosted by the Bayerische Akademie der Wissenschaften (Muenchen). Since 2016 he is member of the Scientific Committee of «Italia medioevale e umanistica».
